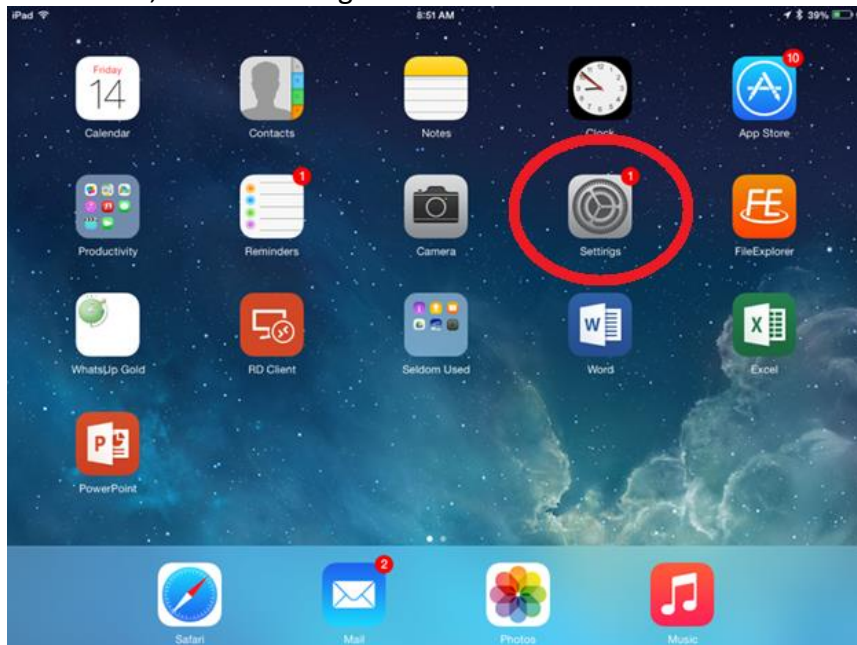


Lynden School District IT Guide: Connecting to the general Wi-Fi network with an iPad

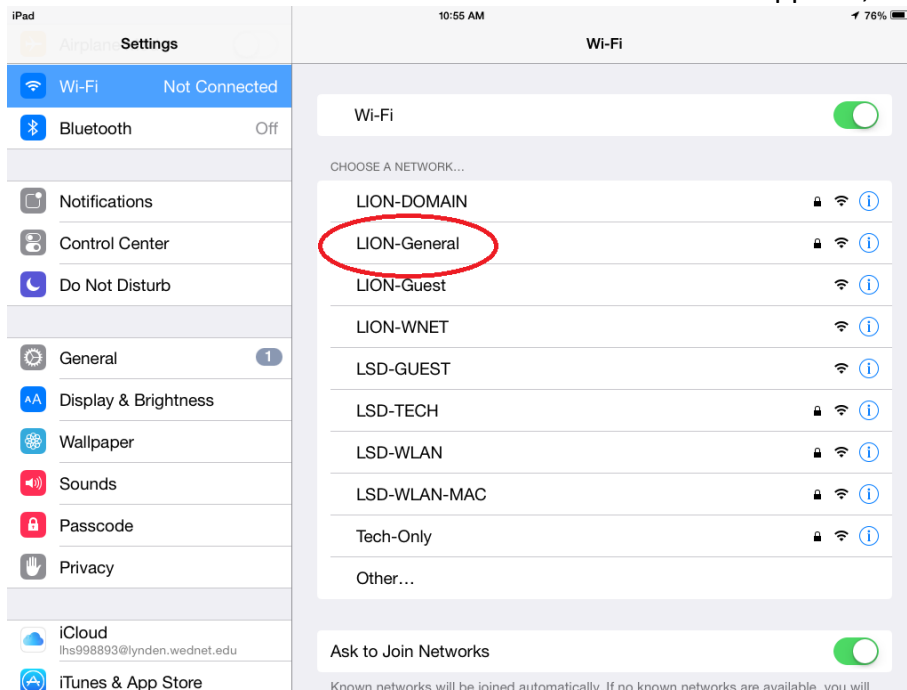
These instructions show settings and selections for connecting an iPad. Other types of phones and tablets should be able to use these procedures as a guide for the specific steps their device uses.

Note: the LION-General network requires a district login id and password. Guest accounts are not permitted on the LION-General network.

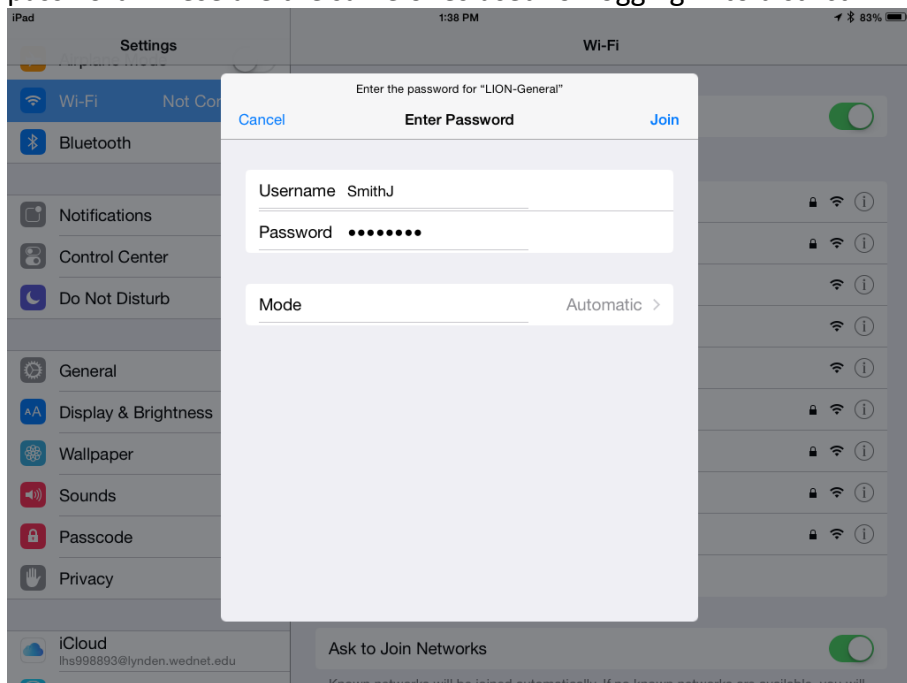
At the iPad, select “Settings”



Then select “Wi-Fi” on the left. When the list of networks appears, select “LION-General”

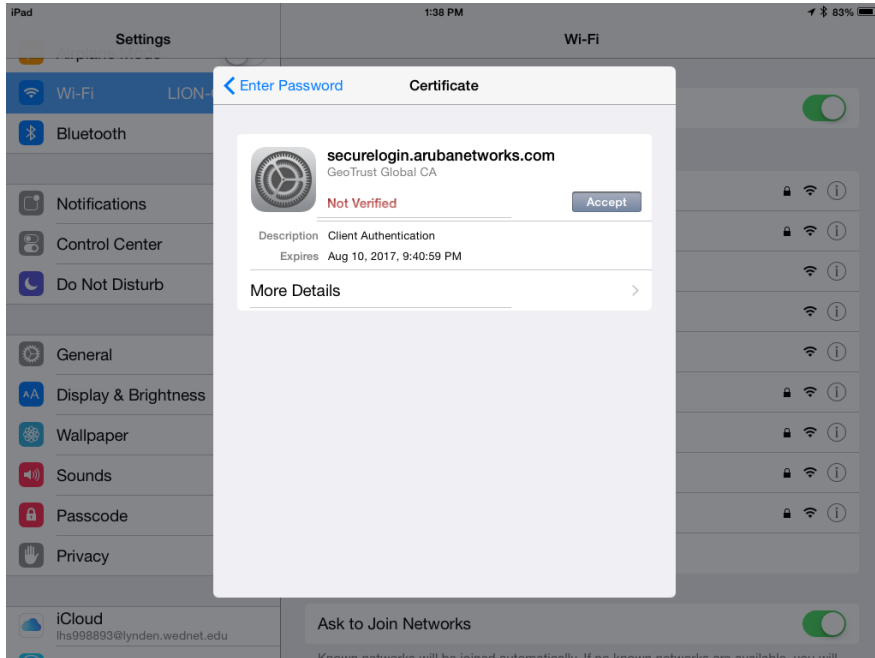


The LION-General network is a secure network, so it will prompt for your username and password. These are the same ones used for logging in to district Windows computers.

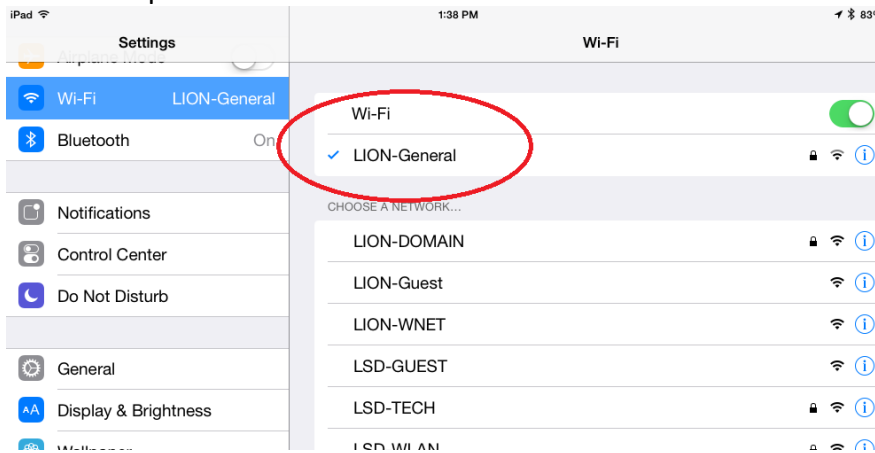


Once you enter the id and password, click “Join”

If successful, it will display the network used to keep the Wi-Fi secure. The prompt will be as shown below and ask you to accept “securelogin.arubanetworks.com”



Click “Accept” to make the client connection to the network.



If the connection is successful, you should see a check-mark next to LION-General. This indicates your device is successfully communicating on the network.
