

Lynden School District IT Guide: Wi-Fi Overview

The Lynden School District provides wireless networking (Wi-Fi) for all staff, students and qualified guests.

Different networks serve different purposes. This guide gives an overview on the various networks and their purpose. Specific instructions for connecting to the networks and services (such as email) can be found in other guides.

The district provides 3 basic Wi-Fi networks, each has a specific purpose:

LION-Domain

This network is restricted to district-owned Windows computers. The IT staff will preconfigure the computer to connect to this network. No other connections are permitted.

LION-General

This network is for all general-purpose networking needs by staff and students. When connected it will prompt for your login id and password (the same one you use on district computers) and provide access.

All devices are supported, including: District-owned tablets and Macintosh computers, personal tablets and cell-phones.

LION-Guest

This network is for district guests who do not have a login account but need access to the Wi-Fi. Access is granted through temporary login accounts provided by the office staff at each school.

Note that this temporary id process does NOT grant access to domain resources (shared disks, files and printers) but only basic access through the firewall
