Lynden FFA Alumni Booster Club Scholarship Application

Qualifications: Applicant must be a senior at Lynden High School and a current FFA member.

This scholarship may be used at any accredited institution including a four-year university/college, community college, vocational tech school, or a qualifying apprenticeship program.

The recipient(s) chosen to receive this scholarship will be judged in the following areas: involvement in and contributions to FFA, leadership skills, participation in and contributions to school and community activities, academic excellence, work experience, SAE project, and evidence of how all of the above have prepared the recipient(s) for their post-secondary goal.

The scholarship will be awarded after completion of the student's first grading period (semester or quarter) at which time the student must provide proof of satisfactory progress and proof of enrollment for the following term.

The scholarship award must be used within two years after graduation from Lynden High School. If not used within this two year period, the scholarship will be forfeited.

- ✓ Return completed application in a sealed envelope to the Lynden High School and Beyond Center.
- ✓ In the case of a tie, a personal interview may be required.
- ✓ Not following these instructions may result in disqualification of application.
