ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicants must be a graduating high school senior within 6 months of June 2024.
- Applicants must be attending an accredited university, college, trade school or institute of higher learning.
- Applicants must NOT have received this scholarship previously.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Read ELIGIBILITY and INSTRUCTIONS thoroughly. Complete the attached application, including: 13 questions, 1 Essay, 2 referrals-1 being from a religious leader and a copy of your transcripts. - 2. <u>All applications must be received by May 24, 2024.</u> All applications should be returned via email to smalpezzi@comcast.net
- 3. If that is not possible, applications can be hand delivered or mailed to St. Joseph Catholic Church, 5781 Hendrickson Ave. Ferndale, WA 98248 (the office is located around back, and they close at 4PM). Applications delivered after May 24th may not be considered.
- 4. Winners will be notified by June 3, 2024.
- 5. Awards will be based on your completeness and quality of answers in your application, essay, references, transcripts, current catholic standing, family member(s) K of C membership, scholastic achievement, service to church and community, and individual need.
