



2026 Scholarship Summary Agriculture/Veterinary Education Scholarship - \$5,000

The Washington State Fair Foundation is pleased to present scholarship opportunities to students for continuing education. Scholarship awards are made possible through the generosity of the Foundation's donors and Board of Directors.

Scholarship Description: The Agriculture/Veterinary Education Scholarship was established in support students interested in pursuing a degree in an agriculture related field or veterinary sciences. The \$5,000 award is paid directly to the recipient's college or university to be used toward tuition or books.

Criteria:

- Must be a resident of Washington
- Senior graduating from high school in the state of Washington and attending an accredited two- or four-year college, university, career or trade school
- Demonstrated interest in the field of agriculture or veterinary sciences, and an intention to pursue a career in one of these fields
- Demonstrated financial need
- Preference may be given to students who have participated in FFA or 4-H
- Unofficial transcripts
- Two letters of recommendation: one from a scholastic contact and one from an employer, volunteer contact, or advisor of school-sponsored activity. Letters written by relatives of the applicant are not allowed.
