ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Financial need is a consideration, and applicants must be:

- A high school senior.
- Planning to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university or vocational/technical school for the entire upcoming academic year.
- Pursuing a degree or certification in a STEM field.
- Interested in a career in the oil and gas, chemical or manufacturing industries.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Recipients will be selected from a pool of qualified applicants. Selection will be based on academic performance, financial need, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, work experience, a statement of career and educational goals and objectives, and unusual personal or family circumstances.



AWARDS

We will accept a maximum of 1,000 applications each award cycle and award up to 66 scholarships each year. Scholarships are given in two amounts: \$2,000 for students pursuing a two-year community college or vocational/technical degree or certification and \$5,000 for students pursuing a four-year college degree.



HOW TO APPLY

The application period is Jan. 5-March 2, 2026, or until 1,000 applications have been submitted. Get program details and apply [here](#). Program Details

- Reaches students with financial need who are interested in STEM and careers in energy, chemicals or manufacturing
- Available to students pursuing university or technical school degrees
- Open to 1,000 applicants (*1 recipient per 15 applicants*)
 - 4-year college degree: \$5,000 per year*
 - 2-year community college or vocational/technical degree: \$2,000 per year*
- Application period runs January 5 – March 2, 2026 (or until the limit of 1,000 applicants is reached)



Consideration is based on academic performance, financial need, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, work experience, a statement of career and educational goals and objectives, and unusual personal or family circumstances.

*The awards are automatically renewed each year provided the student is full-time and meets the minimum GPA requirements.
