The team qualified for National and includes Baily Totten, Presly Schulhauser, Abbey Snydar, Ben Cooley, Katie Vopnford, Tonya Reyna and Leslie Strandgard.
- Kudos to the students at Lynden Middle School who emptied their pockets, piggy banks, turned in their birthday money, looked under sofa cusions, cleaned their rooms and turned in over \$1,500 for our Leukemia & Lymphoma Society "Pennies for Patients" fundraiser! They set a goal of \$1,200 with a stretch goal of \$1,500, and the students exceeded the stretch goal. They demonstrated their care and compassion of others!
- Lynden Middle School successfully completed their Strengthening Families Program dual-language in Spanish and English.
 Twelve families, 8 Spanish and 5 English, participated along with an amazing support staff. We are the only school district in Whatcom County and the Northwest who have (1) two programs running in conjunction with each other dual-language and (2) two full sets of trained facilitators (4 in each program) that are District Employees.
- Isom Elementary has been identified as a 2016 Washington Achievement Award Winner! The award is specifically in the are of "Closing the Achievement Gap for Students with Disabilities".
