

2023-2024 Budget Planning Guiding Principles

The Lynden School District needs to reprioritize resource allocation starting in the 2023-2024 school year. All components of our services and operations will be reviewed for consideration of cost-savings.

The principles outlined below will be used to guide decision-making.

Prioritize Lynden School District's Mission and Vision

- o Mission: All students graduate college, career, and citizenship ready.
- <u>Vision</u>: High quality instruction and learning for every child, every day, in every classroom.
- Focus on additional operational efficiencies
- Reduce/delay implementing non-employee related costs first; what can we cut/hold off in curriculum, travel, optional PD, furniture, equipment
- Encourage enrollment and pursue additional revenue sources- legislature, grants, etc.
- Consider what makes the greatest impact to students, particularly those who had the highest needs
- Honor both the law and negotiated agreements
- Prioritize expenditure of categorical funds in alignment to the intent and objectives of the program (categorical) funding
- Compare state staffing allocation levels to the number of positions we currently maintain with local levy dollars; move toward greater alignment with the state prototypical funding model

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
