- Child's registered birth certificate or passport documentation Birth certificates for children born in Washington State may be obtained at the Whatcom County Health Department Vital Records Office. Call 360-676-6724 or apply online at www.whatcomcounty.us/health. Out of state records may be ordered from www.vitalcheck.com.
- ✓ Current proof of residency

A utility bill, rental agreement or homeowner's policy that shows the parent/guardian's name and address.

- Certificate of Immunization and Health History If you do not have a certificate record, please contact your child's physician or the Whatcom County Health Department at 360-778-6100.
- ✓ Parenting plan/court order, if applicable
- Proof of guardianship if student is living with an adult other than the parent.
