  the staff and students for their hard work!

This family-friendly show was full of familiar characters but with all new songs and an emphasis on family and growing up. All 47 students making up the cast and crew worked together to put on a very successful show!

- Lynden Academy is collaborating with the Northwest Educational Service District for a math professional development series. The first session took place on May 2nd, with a follow up scheduled for May 16th. These sessions are helping teachers strengthen math instruction and continue growing as a team.
