THE ROAD TO QMLATIV

What's Happening and Why

What: Lynden is part of the Northwest Regional Data Center (NWRDC), which provides our systems for student info, HR/payroll, and finance.

When: Our move to Qmlativ is scheduled for April 2026.

Why: The new system offers easier navigation, better access to information, and improved tools for staff.

NOW → DATA CLEANUP → TRAINING → GO LIVE (APRIL 2026)

Who's Involved and How It Works

Who: Every staff member will be affected in some way – from individual use for viewing your paycheck to each building taking student attendance to running weekly financial reports.

How: The district is providing training, resources, and updates as we prepare for the switch.

Behind the Scenes: The District Office team is performing ongoing data cleanup and organizing data to ensure a smooth transfer – known as the Cleanup Process.
