VIEWING GRADES IN FAMILY ACCESS 1. Open the

Skyward Mobile app or login to Skyward Family Access at lynden.wednet.edu with your Skyward Login ID and password.

2. On the **Home** screen, select the **Grading** tile.

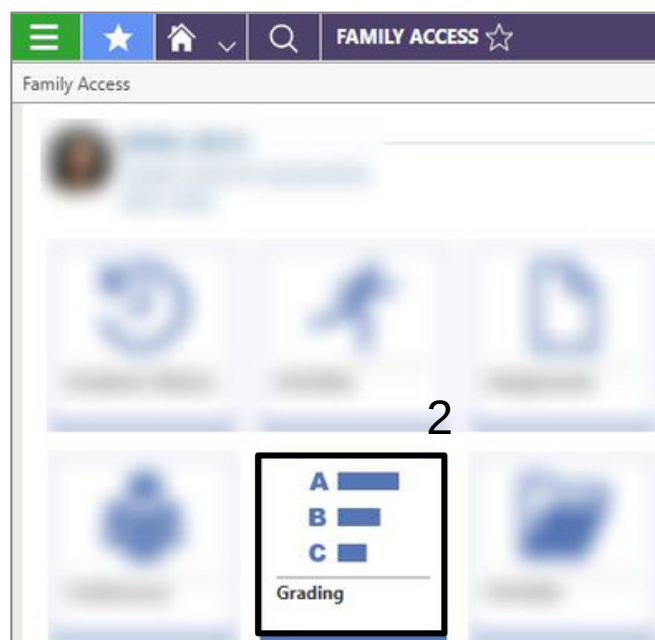

3. The **Student Grades** screen will display all of your student's classes along with the corresponding grading periods.
