Superintendent VanderYacht added that the board's finance committee will also be involved with these discussions.
- Director Sawka added that he agrees about the urgency of safety & security facility needs.
- Director Martinez thanked the audience members who spoke about cell phones and the capital levy failure. He added that the renewal of the EP&O levy will be crucial and require the board's attention.
- Director Brar shared that she submitted the board's WSSDA proposals as approved at the last meeting and provided the outcome of those. She added that she would

like to revisit the weighted voting for state board elections. She then shared about WSSDA's new pilot program which allows boards to submit feedback before WSSDA publishes newly updated model policies and procedures. She shared about upcoming hearings about House Bill 1296 and nondiscrimination. She also shared that WSSDA put out a call for presenters at their Annual Conference in Spokane.

- Sebastian Uribe shared that ASB elections are complete and prom was a success. State testing and AP testing are currently underway. FBLA attended state competition and FFA students are currently at state competition.
- Ashley Acton shared that FFA held their annual plant sale, and it was very successful. She also shared that senior season is in full swing and excitement is building as we approach graduation on June 5th.
